## MICHIGAN SCHOLARSHIPS

### **Michigan ETV Program**

Criteria: Students 18, 19 or 20 years old in foster care or was in foster care as a teenager; enrolled or accepted into a college, university, technical or vocational school.

Award: up to \$5,000 per year

### **Michigan Society of Professional Engineers Scholarships**

Criteria: High School seniors and undergraduate college students enrolled in an engineering program at a Michigan ABET accredited college or university. Must have a 3.0 minimum GPA for 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grades and attain a minimum composite test score of 26 on the ACT exam.

Award: Multiple awards of varying amounts

Deadline: Varies with type of scholarship

### **MHSAA-Farm Bureau Insurance Scholar- Athlete Award**

Criteria: Senior status, enrolled and participating in interscholastic athletics at an MHSAA member school, won a varsity letter in select sports prior to the senior year, 3.5 GPA

Award: Thirty-two \$1,000 scholarships

Deadline: Schools determine their student nominee(s) which must be forwarded to the MHSAA by November.

## NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

### **Casey Family Scholars Program**

Criteria: Young people (under the age of 25) who have spent at least 12 months in foster care pursuing post-secondary education including vocational/technical training. Also includes students who have lost both parents to death before the age of 18 and were not subsequently adopted.

Award: up to \$10,000 - renewable

Deadline: March

### **Komen College Scholarship**

Application is at [www.komen.org/grant](http://www.komen.org/grant) then click on the Awards and Scholarships tab. Look for "College Scholarship Awards."

Criteria: Undergraduate students younger than 25 who have lost a parent to breast cancer and are attending a state-supported college or university in their state of residence.

Award: Seven \$10,000 renewable scholarships

Deadline: February
