Who We Are – we are high school students representing our schools and communities in Allegan County. We are the youth branch of the Allegan County Community Foundation

What We Do – we do community service projects, give out grants, fund and award a scholarship and learn about philanthropy. (Philanthropy is the giving of one's time, treasures or talents.)

What is a Mini-Grant? A mini-grant is a request to the TAG Team by a youth (18 or younger) that is aimed at making a difference in your school or community.

Who Can Apply? Any youth group, club, school or class. The applicant must have an adult leader who oversees the project and any funds awarded.

What difference can you make?

Mini-Grant Rules

1. All mini-grants MUST be handwritten by youth 18 or younger.
2. The project or program must benefit others: youth, families, communities, etc.
3. Eligible applications could be... a community service project, a special speaker for an event, a peer support program, activities that bring together diverse groups.
4. Ineligible applications could be... asking for a scholarship to take a trip, supplies for a classroom (that should be part of the classroom

anyway), projects that only serve those applying.

Mini-Grants should be about youth taking the lead to make a difference for other youth or their community!
